2017 Cat Tale Yearbook to Be Released at 7th Annual Midnight Release Party

Admission is free with the purchase of a 2017 yearbook. Students are required to show proof of identification to pick up all pre-purchased yearbooks.

Students are asked to park in the teachers' parking lot on 5th Street and enter the west doors to the school. The party will be held in the upper Commons.

The PCPD has been notified of this event in accordance with our city's curfew laws, and special curfew-wristbands will be available to any student who requests one.

Students who have purchased a yearbook but are unable to attend the midnight release party, may pick up their yearbooks at Po-Hi on August 7 and 8 at Schedule Pickup.

A limited number of extra yearbooks are available for purchase at the Midnight Release Party and at Scheduled Pickup days. The cost is \$70, while supplies last.
