Common Core Goal: Use writing for a variety of purposes using multiple text types.

LEARNING TARGET: Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose informative/explanatory texts in which they name what they are writing about and supply some information about the topic.

LEVEL OF RIGOR:

ASSESSMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

After learning about a topic (presidents, animals, etc.), students will write 3 sentences about what they know. Students can draw, write and dictate their sentences depending on their ability level.

RUBRIC:

- 4- In addition to score 3, student demonstrates writing beyond what was taught.**
- 3- The student exhibits no major errors or omissions. (Using a combination of drawing, writing, or dictating, student writes or tells what they are writing about and provides 3 sentences about the topic)**
- 2- Student provides partial understanding. (Using a combination of drawing, writing, or dictating, student may write or tell what they are writing about and provides less than 3 sentences about the topic)**
- 1- Student demonstrates no understanding of the concept. (Student cannot write or tell what they are writing about, does not write or dictate on topic)**
