ASSESSMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

Students will be given paper and a choice of writing utensils and a box of counters.

Students will be expected to:

- 1. Select seven counters from a container.**
- 2. Place counters in a line above their paper.**
- 3. Listen as the teacher tells the following story:
7 apples are on a tree. 3 apples fall off the tree. How many apples are left on the tree?**
- 4. Represent the story with the counters.**
- 5. Draw 7 circles to represent apples on their papers.**
- 6. Show that three apples have fallen on the ground.**
- 7. Explain the equation.**

1 – Student attempts the task with little or no success.

2 – Students correctly decompose the manipulatives, but the final outcome was not correct.

3 – With no assistance from the teacher, the student will be able to correctly represent subtraction using manipulatives , drawings, but cannot explain the scenario and outcome.

4 – With no assistance from the teacher, the student will be able to correctly represent subtraction using manipulatives , drawings, and can verbally express the subtraction story.
