3. PUBLIC COMMENT

The Ponca City Public School Board of Education recognizes the value to school governance of public comment on educational issues and the importance of involving members of the public in board meetings. The board has established guidelines to govern public participation in board meetings necessary to conduct its meetings and to maintain order. After checking in with the board clerk, individuals or groups wishing to speak during the public comment period must provide the following information, in writing, in order to speak before the board:

- Name and address of the individual
- The agenda action item(s) the individual wishes to address
- The organization the individual represents or is affiliated with, if applicable

Anyone who would like to speak to the board during public comment period of the meeting must check in with the board clerk *at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the board meeting*. There will be a form available they will need to fill out and return to the board clerk before they can be heard by the board.

Participants must be recognized by the president or other presiding officer and must preface their comments by an announcement of their name and group affiliation, if applicable.

Comments of the speaker must relate to an item on the meeting agenda. Generally, participants shall be limited to comment of a maximum of three (3) minutes duration unless altered by the presiding officer, with the approval of the board. All public comments during any one regular meeting shall be limited to no more than fifteen (15) minutes. No participant may speak more than once during a single meeting. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer; no participant may address or question board members individually.

6.2 Consider and Take Action on the Following Contracts/Agreements:

A. Renewal of Agreement with Burnett Security and Investigation, Inc. for Security at Ponca City High School for the 2019-2020 School Year

Commentary:

This is the renewal of our contract with Burnett Security and Investigation, Inc. for two (2) security guards at Ponca City High School. Cost of the services will be \$16.40 per hour/per student contact days (167 days), with an estimated total cost of \$43,820.80. Bret Smith will answer questions.

B. Renewal of Contract with Burnett Security & Investigation, Inc. for Courier Services for the 2019-2020 School Year

Commentary:

This is a contract between Burnett Security & Investigation, Inc. and Ponca City Public Schools for courier service for 2019-2020. Burnett Security will pick up the deposits from each site and take to the bank. Cost is \$92.00 per school day (167 days) for a total of \$15,364.00. Brenda Storie will answer questions.

C. Agreement with Learning Sciences International for iObservation Renewal for 2019-2020

Commentary:

Learning Sciences International provides iObservation, which is the online instructional and leadership improvement tool used for evaluation. In addition to providing a resource library for teachers and principals to use for instructional growth, iObservation collects, manages and reports longitudinal data from classroom observations. It also calculates an instructional Practice Score for each teacher and leader as required by the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Act. The renewal cost for 2019-2020 is \$20,000.00. Curtis Layton will answer questions.

D. Agreement with Trinity3 Technology for Classroom Chromebooks and Computers for Summer Refresh

Commentary:

This is an agreement with Trinity3 Technology to purchase: 1,350 student-use Chromebooks for Union, Roosevelt, Garfield, and the Freshman Class at PoHi; 100 laptops for teachers at Union, Roosevelt, Garfield and Washington Pre-K; 25 charging carts for the teacher's laptops; 50 Dell desktops for support staff; 400 shell cases for the freshman laptops; and 25 kiosk Chromebox for time clocks. The total cost for the Summer Refresh is \$499,900.00. Jason Ridenour will answer questions.

E. Agreement with Gary Bracken, Attorney at Law, For His Engagement as Attorney for the District

Commentary:

This is a renewal of the Board's agreement with Gary Bracken for his engagement as attorney for the school district. This is the twenty-second year the district has contracted services with Mr. Bracken based on a retainer fee for non-litigation matters. The retainer fee for the 2019-2020 school year will be \$44,400.00. Shelley Arrott will answer questions.

F. Agreement with Rosenstein, Fist & Ringold for Legal Services

Commentary:

This agreement is for legal services rendered by Rosenstein, Fist & Ringold. The cost is on an "as needed" basis and will encompass work requested by the Superintendent or the Board of Education. The estimated cost for 2019-2020 is \$10,000.00, based on the prior school year expenses. Shelley Arrott will answer questions.

G. Agreement with FilteredNet dba Andrews Network Enterprise, Inc. to Purchase Family Zone Content Filter Software

Commentary:

Family Zone web/content filter is the package that we have chosen to replace LightSpeed for our content filtering. Currently, we have been piloting it as a proof of concept for the last 90 days. The ability of this software to filter out malicious and harmful content has proven to be much better than our previous software. The cost is \$26,500.00 for 15 months, April 1, 2019 thru June 30, 2020. Jason Ridenour will answer questions.

H. Agreement with Haddock Education Technologies to Purchase Promethean Boards

Commentary:

This agreement is to replace 45 Promethean Boards at Union, Roosevelt, and Garfield as part of the summer refresh. The cost is \$165,099.76. Jason Ridenour will answer questions.

I. Agreement with Hindman Enterprises LLC dba Hindman Lawn Care for District Lawn Service

Commentary:

This agreement is for mowing, weed eating, edging, and blowing concrete districtwide, commencing May 1, 2019 thru April 30, 2020. The cost for FY19 is \$12,580.00 and FY20 is \$22,015.00, totaling \$34,595.00. Bret Smith will answer questions.

J. Agreement with Heather Wilson, CCC-SLP, to Provide Speech and Language Services for the 2019-2020 School Year

Commentary:

Ms. Heather Wilson, CCC-SLP, Independent Contractor, will provide speech and language services for students enrolled in Ponca City Public Schools as indicated by parental consent and school criteria. The District will identify the students who need the services and shall approve each individual situation as provided for under state and federal regulations. The cost of services will be \$60.00 per hour for the 2019-2020 school year. The total cost of the agreement is \$81,000.00. Amy Swartz will answer questions.

K. Agreement with Brandi Aud, CCC-SLP, to Provide Speech and Language Services for the 2019-2020 School Year

Commentary:

Brandi Aud, CCC-SLP, Independent Contractor, will provide speech and language services for students enrolled in Ponca City Public Schools as indicated by parental consent and school criteria. The District will identify the students who need the services and shall approve each individual situation as provided for under state and federal regulations. The cost of services will be \$65.00 per hour, up to 4 days per week, for the 2019-2020 school year. The total cost of the agreement is \$70,200.00. Amy Swartz will answer questions.

L. Agreement with Judy Cardwell, CCC-SLP, to Provide Speech and Language Services for the 2019-2020 School Year

Commentary:

Ms. Judy Cardwell, CCC-SLP, Independent Contractor, will provide speech

and language services for students enrolled in Ponca City Public Schools as indicated by parental consent and school criteria. The District will identify the students who need the services and shall approve each individual situation as provided for under state and federal regulations. The cost of services will be \$68.00 per hour for the 2019-2020 school year. The total cost of the agreement is \$93,130.00. Amy Swartz will answer questions.

M. Agreement with City of Ponca City-RecPlex for the Use of Pool and Aquatic Facilities

Commentary:

This agreement is for the use of pool and aquatic facilities for swimming instruction, special education aquatic programs, and swimming for an athletic sport. The cost is \$15,000.00 for FY20. Bret Smith will answer questions.

N. Agreement with Evans & Associates Construction Co., Inc. for Parking Lot and Sidewalk Repairs at the Concert Hall

Commentary:

This agreement is with Evans & Associates Construction Co., Inc. and the City of Ponca City for parking lot and sidewalk repairs at the new Concert Hall. The City of Ponca City will be responsible for 55% of the cost and Ponca City Schools 45%. The total estimated cost is \$49,389.00. The District's share will be \$17,676.00. If additional base patching is needed the cost would be \$9.50/SF @ 726.7 SF for an estimated cost of \$6,903.65. The total cost for the District is \$24,579.65. The City's cost will be \$24,810.25. Bret Smith will answer questions.

O. Agreement with Beasley Technology, Inc. to Purchase and Install Cameras at Four (4) Sites

Commentary:

Beasley Technology, Inc. will install 80 cameras at four (4) District locations; PoHi, East Middle School, West Middles School, and Washington Pre-K. The total cost for all sites is \$70,747.50. Jason Ridenour will answer questions.

P. Agreement with Beasley Technology, Inc. to Purchase Video Management Software

Commentary:

This agreement is to replace our existing camera software and move all 243 cameras into the new Video Management Software. Also included is the

installation of servers and storage to insure that we will be able to have a minimum of 14 days of recording for all cameras. The cost is \$70,611.00. Jason Ridenour will answer questions.
